**ORDER**

Mr. K. Moorthy, Advocate appears for the Applicant / RP through video conferencing platform.

This Application is filed under Section 12 (2) of IBC, 2016 seeking extension of CIRP period. The CIRP commenced by the order dated 20.04.2021 and 180 days of the CIRP ended on 18.10.2021.

Subsequently, IA/577/2021 has been filed and the order was passed on 28.01.2022. Subsequently the Hon'ble Supreme Court passed an order in MA/21/2022 and MA/665/2021 vide suo moto Writ Petition No.03/2020 excluding the time limit of the CIRP due to Covid-19 pandemic and thereby extended 270 days of the CIRP period which shall end on 29.05.2022.

This Application is filed seeking exclusion of time line of CIRP period from 28.01.2022 to 28.02.2022.

Thereafter Learned Counsel for the Petitioner states that in the 7<sup>th</sup> CoC meeting held on 06.01.2022, the resolution was passed with 92.20% voting share for seeking an extension of 90 days in respect of the CIRP period.

Heard submissions made by Learned Counsel for the Applicant.

Accordingly, IA/104(CHE)/2022 stands **Allowed**, as prayed for.
